Unconsented contact or course of conduct includes, but is not limited to: (a.) following or appearing within the sight of that individual, (b.) approaching or confronting that individual in a public place or on private property, (c.) appearing at the workplace or residence of that individual, (d.) entering onto or remaining on property owned, leased, or occupied by that individual, (e.) contacting that individual by telephone, (f.) sending mail or electronic communications to that individual, or (g.) placing an object on, or delivering an object to, property owned, leased or occupied by that individual; 22 O.S. §60.1(2). 6. Warnings To Petitioner:

A. Whoever makes a statement or allegation in this Petition for Protective Order but does not believe that the statement or allegation is true, or knows that it is not true, or intends thereby to avoid or obstruct the ascertainment of the truth, may be found guilty of perjury. Pursuant to 21 O.S. §§500 and 504, the penalty for perjury, or subornation of perjury, is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than five (5) years.

B. If the court makes specific findings that a petition for a protective order has been filed frivolously and no victim exists, the court may assess attorney fees and court costs against the plaintiff pursuant to 22 O.S. §60.2 (C)(2).

C. It is against the law to file a petition for a protective order against a spouse or former spouse for the purposes of harassment, undue advantage, intimidation or limitation of child visitation rights in any divorce proceeding or separation action without justifiable cause. Violators may be subject to criminal penalties pursuant to 22 O.S. §60.4(H).

	On 01/21/2018 at approx. 15:31 Hrs. Kelly Compton came to the McCurtain County Sheriff's Department to make a report in reference to her supervised visitation. Ms. Compton stated that she pays Jason Ricketts \$20/Hr. for court ordered supervised visitation to see her 12 year old daughter. Ms. Compton stated that in December of 2017 Mr. Ricketts contacted her by phone and yelled and made threats toward her about making her life hell in court in reference to her visitation. Ms. Compton stated that on 01/14/2018 she contacted Mr. Ricketts about picking up her daughter for visitation and he told her that his family was sick and he couldn't do the visitation. Ms. Compton stated that she called Mr. Ricketts the next to try to get her visitation and she was told that her ex-husband said that she couldn't see her until today so she told him that she would be in Broken Bow around 2:00 pm and to let her know where to meet him for visitation. Ms. Compton stated that on 01/20/2018 at 18:11 Hrs. she sent Mr. Ricketts a text message asking him what time was he picking up her daughter for visitation today and she never got a response from him so at 10:30 Hrs. this morning she sent him another text message in reference to visitation time today and she said that he became abrupt with her by text message. Ms. Compton stated that Mr. Ricketts has threatened to make untrue statements in court against her several times. Ms. Compton stated that at 14:08 Hrs. Mr. Ricketts sent her a text message stating that he could pick up her daughter at 16:00 Hrs. which at that time she felt that it was unsafe for her or her daughter to be alone with him anymore as far as her future court hearings because she was in fear of what Mr. Ricketts may try to say about her. Ms. Compton stated that she feels that Mr. Ricketts may try to use his status against her because he would pick up her daughter in his patrol vehicle when he was employed at the Sheriff's Office for visitation of her daughter and he had spoken about ongoing investigations in front of her and her daughter in the past during visitations. Ms. Compton stated that she wanted all of this documented to cover her just in case Mr. Ricketts attempted to falsify information about her in reference to her visitations. Ms. Compton also stated that she is going to go talk to Judge Brock in the morning about getting some type of order in place to where she and her daughter won't have to be alone with him for her supervised visitations because she doesn't feel comfortable at this point. Pictures of text messages were taken that were sent back and forth between Ms. Compton and Mr. Ricketts in reference to this report. This report is for civil/information purposes only by the request of Kelly Compton to be available for future incidents if needed. Contact with Jason Ricketts has not been made as of this time, but I will make contact with him in reference to this matter.

1 PARSONS, SCOTT (Continued)

At approx. 05:00 Hrs. Jason Ricketts called me and stated that he was told by Ms. Compton's ex-husband Darren that his daughter was not to get in a vehicle with him because he was under an investigation and he was wanting to know what was going on. I advised Mr. Ricketts that there was no investigation taken place against him and that I spoke to Ms. Compton earlier and she wanted a report made because she doesn't feel comfortable with him being over her supervised visitation due to allegations being made by him and she felt that her daughter shouldn't be in a vehicle alone with him. Mr. Ricketts stated that everything that Ms. Compton is alleging is false and that he records every phone conversation with her because it's been trouble ever since he has been overseeing their visitation.

I explained to Mr. Ricketts that it was just a civil matter and that I was just doing a report per the request of Kelly Compton and he was not under any criminal investigation by any means. He stated that the ex-husband was upset but he would call him back and let him know what was going on with the situation and that there was no criminal investigation underway against him. I advised Mr. Ricketts that Ms. Compton was going to see about having the visitation changed to where he wasn't the person supervising it and that is what the main issue we talked about. He explained that he understood what was going on and said that he would call the ex-husband so he would calm down. This information report is complete at this time!!!
