Narrative Report

While uniformed and off-duty, returning to my residence after a shift assisting the Sedgwick Co Sheriffs Office with event security at INTRUST Arena, I was driving my personally owned vehicle westbound on Kellogg near West Street in the City of Wichita. At approx. 2154 hrs I observed another westbound vehicle rapidly approaching my vehicle from behind, and traveling at what was an extremely high rate of speed. The vehicle neared by location, and then made a sudden lane change to the far southern (passing) lane without the use of a signal and in a very reckless manner. As the vehicle passed me on the left, I heard a loud scraping noise and observed a spray of sparks be emitted from aside the vehicle, which continued westbound. Initially, I feared that the driver had scraped the side of my vehicle, as the room between the two cars was minimal, but then quickly surmised that the vehicle had either hit something within the road or along the shoulder on Kellogg. The vehicle passed me so quickly that I could not determine how many occupants were inside the Jeep, nor any other particulars. The vehicle continued westbound and made a lane change across the 3 lanes to exit onto I-235 NB and again without any signalling intention, nearly striking two other westbound vehicles in their proper lanes.

I got on the radio, and requested any unit nearby to attempt to stop the errant driver, who I thought could be impaired, given his very poor driving (Follow Too Close, Speed Greater than Reasonable, Unsafe Passing, Failure to Signal) and the time of the night. As I also exited, the suspect vehicle was forced to slow to enter the freeway and I was able to catch up to it and relay a tag number to the dispatcher. The vehicle entered I-235, crossing both lanes and entering the passing lane under hard acceleration. I flashed my lights at the vehicle, of which I was immediately behind, in an attempt to make them aware that their driving was observed and in the hopes that they would slow to prevent a horrific accident. I also thought that the driver could be medically impaired or under the influence of drugs given thei maniacal driving I was witnessing. In approx. 40 years of traffic enforcement, I had witnessed few such egregious incidents as this. As I relayed the route of travel and violations, indicating to dispatch I believed the driver to be impaired, a KHP ground Trooper and the KHP aircraft both indicated that they were moving into the area.

The Jeep continued NB on I-235, passing on the shoulder, and weaving through traffic repeatedly, as I attempted to keep up with it and continue observation. The driver came up upon several cars, having to abruptly brake, before veering around them on both the left and right shoulders. It occurred to me that the driver could have just been involved in a crime and was trying to evade whomever, as speeds were estimated at 90 mph through this time frame.

As the suspect truck approached the exit with Zoo Boulevard, it veered from the passing lane, moved across the driving lane, and very recklessly exited onto the ramp, entering the right shoulder and kicking up a cloud of dust and debris, like had previously been apparently witnessed on Kellogg at initial contact. The Jeep careened down the curved ramp at a very unsafe speed, while I updated dispatch on its actions. At the bottom of the ramp, the vehicle turned east onto Zoo Blvd, and went a short distance before executing a wide sweeping u-turn to begin westbound travel. As I turned to continue following, I heard the KHP aircraft check in the area and overheard other units getting close.

The suspect vehicle traveled to the intersection with Windmill Blvd, and the air unit advised that they had the vehicle in sight. As the Jeep turned SB onto Windmill, it accelerated to over 100 mph quickly and continued south, continuing onto 13th Street North where the two roadways merge. I radioed that I was not following any longer due to the very unsafe speeds and that the KHP plane had visual now. I watched as the vehicle's tail-lamps turned to brake lamps, and the truck made a turn onto Scouller Street (1 block east of Ridge Road) before disappearing into the neighborhood. As the air unit continued to follow and call out locations, I asked dispatch to provide the tag return and she did so, advising that the Jeep was registered to 7434 W. Warren in Wichita, which I knew to be nearby.

As the target vehicle went through various neighborhoods while being monitored by the plane, A KHP supervisor indicated that they were enroute to the Warren address, and I began to drive that way as well. Other units were also inbound to this protracted event, due to the absolute dangerous driving and multiple violations reported by myself and Air One.

After approx 3 minutes, the aircraft Trooper shared that the vehicle in question had traveled to the Warren Street address, and that the driver had attempted to hide the vehicle aside the home, and then had ran into the residence there. Within 30 seconds of this transmission, I was driving NB on Warren and upon observing that I was getting near the address, I slowed and stopped my Suburban along the curb, just south of the address to await the arrival of other units, in particular the KHP Lieutenant who had said he was "close". I could see the same Jeep parked on the south side of the home in the yard, and observed an interior light on within it, and movement.

Almost simultaneous to this, the front door of the home flew open, and a smaller framed white male burst out the front with something in his hand that appeared to be a pistol. He was pointing the item towards me and I immediately left from my truck and shouted "Police Officer, stop!" to which the man immediately turned and ran back into the house. As I stepped forward to a better position of cover along the engine block of my vehicle, I then thus observed people exiting the Jeep in the yard, and much screaming began to be directed towards me. At this moment, the KHP Trooper pulled up from the north and stopped and exited, just as the previously mentioned white male charged towards me on foot in the front yard. The man was screaming profanities towards me, as I closed the distance towards him and stated "So you were driving?" to which he replied affirmatively and continued to berate me, as did the other individuals from the truck. The KHP Lieutenant joined me at the suspect, who refused to follow directions, and began to re-enter the Jeep. I continued to attempt to engage the man, but he was enraged, and completely out of control. At this time, after telling him to show me his drivers license, he tried to pick up a child that was within the vehicle and I grabbed ahold of him and told him that he was under arrest. The subject began to actively resist, as his gathered family members began to defend him and attempt to assist him. The KHP Lt. and I were put out "in trouble" after communicating this failure to comply and the number of combatants.

While wrestling with him, I observed a large cannister fall from his jacket pocket that I identified as a likely plastic dispensary container. The odor of burnt marijuana was now apparent on the man as we were in physical contact and he was pulling away and attempting to flee. The man was handcuffed and led to the side of the street in advance of being placed in another patrol unit that had begun to arrive in response to the call for assistance. Prior to this, a woman angrily approached me and demanded that I stop and when I threatened her with aerosol, she did not yield and I was forced to push her backwards and away from the Trooper and I. She then began to claim police abuse and was screaming to nobody in particular. After placing the man down near the curb, I turned to recover the discarded item of contraband and it was missing from where I had seen it last. The KHP air unit told me over the air that one of the other parties had picked something up and ran inside with it, and I noted that this person had just emerged out of the house. (Later identified as Stacy Lynn Sublett, the wife of Joseph SUBLETT)

As the subject, now identified as Joseph SUBLETT sat in the grass, he claimed to begin experiencing a seizure, and began to exhibit symptoms of same. His family, all still in the area, encroached upon the scene and began screaming at us that he suffers from seizures, and to "Let him go" and related statements. I called for EMS to respond, and we then relocated his handcuffs to the front as the subject began to apparently actively seize. The family members said that this happened when he "was stressed" and continued to be aggressive in their behavior and speech. As more units arrived, we had to back the family members up to preserve scene security and officer safety.

Upon the arrival of EMS, SUBLETT stated that he wanted to be taken to the hospital, and they packaged and transported him. He reiterated to medics that he had seizures, and had just had one. I stated to him that he was not under arrest if he was in need of medical assistance. I tried to calm the family with this news and to de-escalate their anxiety and anger, to little avail.

During this time frame, I went to Stacy Sublett and explained to her that I knew she had taken the marijuana inside the home, and she initiatly denied doing so. I told her that the air section above had seen her do it and that the only person

who could have possibly done it was her, and demanded her identification. She began to argue vehemently with me about the chronology of events, and I told her that she was not returning inside the home, and that it was being secured for investigation. I explained to her that it was my intent to attempt to procure a search warrant for the home, and unless and until such request was made, the residence was inaccessible.

Stacy SUBLETT then stated "I didn't know what it was" and "I just took it inside because it fell out of his pocket". I told her that she needed to retrieve and return it, and she agreed. Myself and a Trooper accompanied her into the home by consent. As I entered the front door, immediately to my right was a Sig P365 handgun, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The Trooper stood by with the weapon while I followed Stacy Sublett to the kitchen where she pointed to a cannister sitting atop a counter there, which was the same cannister I had seen outside on the ground. I opened it and saw that it contained a significant quantity of green vegetation that appeared and smelled of raw cannabis. I collected the item, thanked Stacy Sublett and took the item to my vehicle to secure it. The Trooper conducted an inquiry of the pistol through his dispatch, and found that it was not stolen.

Upon returning outside, EMS advised that they were transporting SUBLETT by his request to St. Francis Hospital. He claimed no injuries from the detention, but just that he had experienced a seizure, and it was mentioned that he was epileptic.

A search of the Jeep revealed no items of contraband, though the family was extremely upset with my searching of the motor vehicle, and stood-by filming while I did so.

After law enforcement was able to clear the scene, I departed and traveled to St. Francis Hospital where security led me to SUBLETT, who was in an exam room. I attempted to speak to SUBLETT, who was surrounded by family members, but he and they began to yell at me, causing hospital security to summon additional officers, before some of the family was ushered out of the room. Once some degree of calm had been restored, I entered the room again, and read aloud the State Implied Consent Advisory DC70 to SUBLETT, and asked him to submit to a blood test, given my professional opinion, observations, and the totality of evidence that he was operating under the influence of drugs. SUBLETT responded loudly and angrily "Attorney". I attempted to explain to him that he had no right to consult with an attorney at this point, and he simply responded "Attorney. Call my attorney. I asked him directly several times, will you consent to a blood test, and then finally told him that I would ask him one final time and if he did not answer it would be deemed a refusal and that he would likely lose his license for a year. He and the others continued to loudly speak over me, so I dropped the completed DC-27 upon this lap in the gurney, advising him that he was served and should read the information on the reverse side of the document and consult with an attorney. I then departed the hospital and went to the Bentley PD to complete reporting and log the evidence into secure holding.

The suspected marijuana was submitted to the lab on 01/15/25 and a report returned by Lana J. Goodson on 02/27/25 indicating that the suspected substance was confirmed as marijuana containing THC with a certified weight of 6.83 grams.

A check of SUBLETT's criminal history revealed that he was a convicted felon, and prohibited from possessing a firearm, following a conviction for possessing controlled substances on 02/09/07 under Sg Co case 04C037168, and a conviction for domestic violence on 02/09/17. SUBLETT was arrested, but not charged with being a felon in possession of a firearm by the Sedgwick Co DA on 08-18-2023.

At this time, additional information will be the subject of subsequent supplemental reporting filed under this case number.

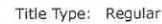

(ii) was adjudicated as a juvenile offender because of the commission of an act which if done by an adult would constitute the commission of a person felony;

(B) was not found by the convicting court to have used a firearm in the commission of such crime; and

(ii) was adjudicated as a juvenile offender because of the commission of an act which if done by an adult would constitute the commission of a nonperson felony; and

(B) less than three months have elapsed since such person satisfied the sentence imposed or the terms of any diversion agreement for such crime, or was discharged from probation, a community correctional services program, parole, postrelease supervision, conditional release or a suspended sentence.

(b) Criminal possession of a weapon by a convicted felon is a severity level 8, nonperson felony.

(c) The provisions of subsections (a)(1), (a)(2) and (a)(4) shall not apply to a person who has been convicted of a crime and has had the conviction of such crime expunged or has been pardoned for such crime.

(d) As used in this section:

(1) "Knife" means a dagger, dirk, switchblade, stiletto, straight-edged razor or any other dangerous or deadly cutting instrument of like character; and

(2) "weapon" means a firearm or a knife.

CASE ANNOTATIONS

1. When a defendant receives a suspended sentence in Missouri and successfully completes probation, the suspended sentence counts as a "prior conviction" to establish criminal possession of a firearm in Kansas. *State v. Howard*, 51 Kan. App. 2d 28, 36, 339 P.3d 809 (2014).

2. Defendant's guilty pleas and successful completion of suspended imposition sentences in Missouri constituted "convictions" under Kansas law as predicate offenses. *State v. Evans*, 51 Kan. App. 2d 168, 177, 343 P.3d 122 (2015).

3. A folding knife qualified as a dangerous or deadly cutting instrument of like character. *State v. Lucas*, 58 Kan. App. 2d 34, 37, 462 P.3d 1208 (2020).

4. The residual clause "or any other dangerous or deadly cutting instrument of like character" is unconstitutionally vague. *State v. Harris*, 311 Kan. 816, 467 P.3d 504 (2020).
