Narrative:

On 11/1/2024 at 21:53 hours while riding as the 113 uniformed Wichita Police patrol officer, I R. Barnthouse C2695 went to assist KHP with a possible intoxicated driver at 7434 W Warren, Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

While in route to the call, dispatch advised that a trooper was out in trouble.

Upon arriving on scene, I saw a KHP Trooper and a Bentley Police Officer standing near a man who they had in handcuffs. The Bentley officer asked if they could place the suspect in a Wichita Police patrol vehicle. I opened the back of the 112 patrol vehicle and they placed Joseph Sublett into the vehicle. Joseph told me that he wanted his medication that he takes for seizures. Right after telling me that, Joseph began to have a seizure. I pulled Joseph out of the back of the patrol vehicle and laid him on the ground. I asked for EMS to come to the scene and asked for a 10-39 response. I placed Joseph on his left side and put my left hand under his head to hold his head up.

I did this to prevent Joseph from hitting his head on the pavement. Once Joseph stopped having a seizure, we sat him up so he could get more oxygen. Joseph started talking to us and then started to have a second seizure. After Joseph had the second one, I allowed the family to come talk to him in an attempt to calm him down so he would not have another seizure.

Fire and EMS arrived on scene and EMS loaded Joseph into the ambulance and transported him to the hospital.

I later learned that Bentley Police Chief Bryan BE1 was heading home from a part time when a vehicle almost struck his personal vehicle. The vehicle then continued driving and Chief Bryan followed the vehicle and called it out for KHP. KHP air1 began to follow the vehicle as well. The vehicle stopped at 7434 W Warren and the driver ran into the residence. The driver then came out of the residence with a handgun. The driver (Joseph Sublett) then went back into the house and put the gun away before KHP arrived on scene.

On (11/01/2024) at 2207hrs while working as a one officer unit (13B) in Wichita, Sedgwick County KS, I was dispatched to an officer in trouble located at 7434 W. Warren.

Upon arriving on scene Officer Barnthouse advised me to keep (O1) Joseph Sublett away from the suspect. I told Joseph to back away and kept him back from the suspect who he identified as his father. I observed that Joseph's father was having seizures and officers had called for EMS to arrive on scene. I advised Joseph to stay back to give the officer's space and Joseph complied and stayed near me. I later was relieved from the scene.

Narrative:

On November 2, 2024, I, Ofc. K. Brandt 2911 was riding as a one officer unit, assigned patrol west, 15 beat, 4th watch. At 2201 hours, I was dispatched to 7434 W. Warren for an officer in trouble call.

When I arrived on scene, I observed a KHP trooper and another officer had a male subject handcuffed and on his knees up by 7434 W. Warren to the south of this residence. While they were dealing with the handcuffed individual, I observed a teenaged white male coming up towards us. I stopped him and he told me he was the male subject's son. I told him he needed to let the officers deal with his father and he continued to ask if he could talk to him. I told him he would have to wait until officer's were done doing their job and he would possibly have a chance to speak to his father a little later. This male was later identified as 17 yo, Joseph Sublett.

I stayed on scene and assisted with the detained male individual as he had two seizures in our presence. EMS was requested and medic 38 arrived on scene. The male subject was transported code yellow to St. Francis.

At this time, I have nothing further to report. Axon submitted, Sgt. Hall on scene.
