

Additional Comment.

Mr. Taylor's provided the **FALSE** information. This is my additional comment and evidence for what happened on Oct 28, that is corresponded to Mr. Taylor's response item 4.

In my original complain: "On October 28, 2022, I went to the court as scheduled second time. Mr. Taylor approached me again. He said he was surprised that I was there again, then said "never mind". Then, **he talked to a woman** pointing at me. After the court proceeding started at 9:00 am, he gestured for me to go to his table. Then he produced a blue form, asked me to sign at the place he marked, and said, "your case is dropped." Then he took back the form and signed himself."

1. The lady I mentioned is in middle age, and she may directly work for the court. She might be able to provide the information what Mr. Taylor said to her.
2. In the court room after the court session started, from the beginning to ending, the only words Mr. Taylor said to me was: "sign here, your case is dropped". After signature was finished, I walked out the court. In outside of court building, I made a call to my husband at 9:06. My phone detailed is attached. There was only 6 minutes in court session. I would like to ask Mr. Taylor what you had done in such short period of time? What did you said to me in specific statements?
