PETITION TO RESCIND STATUTORY SUMMARY
SUSPENSION - REFUSAL

I hereby petition the Court to rescind the Statutory Summary Suspension heretofore issued in this case due to the issue(s) of:

1. The officer did not have reasonable, articulable suspicion to believe that a traffic or criminal offense had been committed or was about to be committed.
2. I was not lawfully placed under arrest for an offense as defined in Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol/Drugs) or a similar provision of a local ordinance, as evidenced by the issuance of a Uniform Traffic Ticket or other form of charge.
3. The arresting officer did not have reasonable grounds to believe that I was driving or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle upon a highway while under the influence of alcohol and/or other drugs, or a combination thereof.
4. I was not properly warned by the arresting officer as provided in Section 11-501.1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
5. I did not refuse to submit to and/or complete the required chemical test or tests, pursuant to Section 11-501.1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, upon the request of the arresting officer.
6. That the arresting officer did not properly serve the Petitioner with the requisite Notice of Statutory Summary Suspension in accordance with Section 11-501.1

Standardized Field Sobriety Testing refreshers- NHTSA does not set guidelines for refresher training. IDOT does set a guideline for refresher training -As of 12/28/15, the previous IDOT grant requirement for two year refreshers has been changed to every four years.

Page 4 of IDOT [Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program \(STEP\)](#) guidelines -All officers conducting grant funded, alcohol-related enforcement patrols must be trained in the Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFST). To satisfy this requirement, officers must complete an ILETSB accredited academy; a 24-hour SFST course or a SFST refresher course every four years from the date of their last completed certified training. These courses must be taught by certified SFST instructors. **Note:** The IDOT document states - A department may provide in-house training for its own officers, provided the trainer is a certified SFST instructor. Officers may also attend training at an agency other than their own provided the training is conducted by a certified instructor. In these situations, a class roster showing all officers who completed the training must be sent to the ILETSB. Upon request, departments must be able to produce verification of compliance with this requirement. **Successful completion of a Board Certified ARIDE class will also satisfy the SFST refresher.**

School Resource Officer- Eff. January 1, 2019 [105 ILCS 5/10-20.67](#) Sec. 10-20.67. "School resource officer" means a law enforcement officer who has been primarily assigned to a school or school district under an agreement with a local law enforcement agency. Beginning January 1, 2021, any law enforcement agency that provides a school resource officer under this Section shall provide to the school district a certificate of completion, or approved waiver,.... within one year of assignment. See [ILETSB mandate](#)

THE ILETSB is expected to release & waiver training criteria for the SRO in September 2020

FIVE YEAR REQUIREMENTS

HB 5538 ([PA 99-0810](#)) Effective January 1, 2017-Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 and the Illinois Domestic Violence Act of 1986.

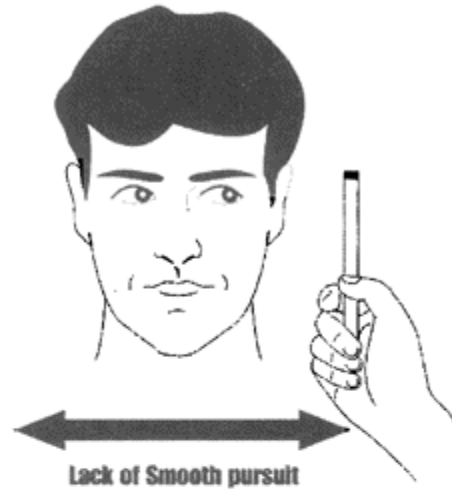
- Provides that in **developing ARREST PROCEDURE POLICIES IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE** situations, each law enforcement agency shall (instead of "is encouraged to") consult with community organizations and other law enforcement agencies with expertise in recognizing and handling domestic violence incidents.
- Provides that in the initial training of new recruits and **every 5 years** in the continuing education of law enforcement officers, every law enforcement agency shall provide training to aid in **understanding the actions of domestic violence victims and abusers** and to prevent further victimization of those who have been abused, focusing specifically on **looking beyond the physical evidence to the psychology of domestic violence situations**, such as **the dynamics of the aggressor-victim relationship, separately evaluating claims where both parties claim to be the victim, and long-term effects.**
- Provides that the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board shall formulate and administer the training as part of the current programs for both new recruits and active law enforcement officers
- Provides that the Board shall formulate the training by July 1, 2017, and implement the training statewide by July 1, 2018
- Provides that in formulating the training, the Board shall work with community organizations with expertise in domestic violence to determine which topics to include
- Provides that the Illinois Department of State Police shall oversee the implementation and continual administration of the training. With amendments see [site for more details](#).

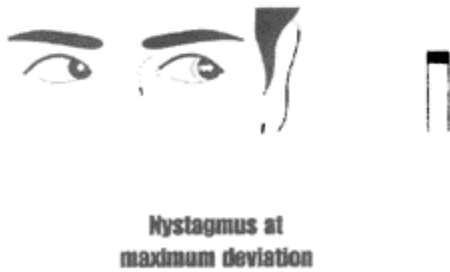

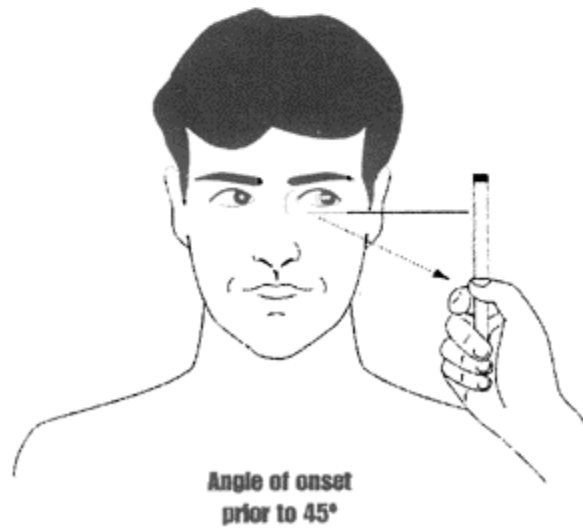

Fabricated Affidavit

1. On the signature line of the affidavit you can notice that it was signed by an officer who wasn't a witness or involved in the investigation until after it was concluded.
2. On the affidavit it specifies that officer Robert Trout was the first person to arrive at 3541 Normandy Ave despite this Mc Nutt places in his police report and court testimony that he was the first officer at the location.
3. In the affidavit it alleges that Trout & Mc Nutt smelled odor of alcohol on Sergio's breath despite this both officers had particle mask on over their mouth and nose before and after the investigation.
4. In the affidavit it specifies that Robert Trout had allegedly seen Sergio with glossy eyes despite that in his police report depicts him as wearing prescription glasses at the time of his observation which was an improper method of checking eyes according to NHTSA (NHTSA Participant Manual Sess 3:P.20)
5. In the affidavit it alleges that Robert Trout was a witness to an alleged vehicular accident or that it was known to him as fact. But when referencing Mc Nutt's police report nothing is ever mentioned about them being a witness to any such occurrence.
6. In the affidavit it specifies that Mc Nutt used the same terminology as Robert Trout when describing an alleged odor of alcohol on Sergio's breath regardless that Mc Nutt never used that terminology in his report.
7. In the affidavit it specifies that Sergio refused to take a preliminary breath test which was contradictory to Trout's police report that all Sergio did was inform him that they were on private property.
8. On a side note: In both police reports the officers identified Sergio as the neighbor's dad by their description of what he was wearing that night. Apart from this in Trout's motion to suppress deposition specified that most of his investigative information came from Mc Nutt regardless that Mc Nutt wasn't the one to fill out the affidavit. In conclusion the officer that signed the affidavit was never subpoenaed or required to show up in court.

I spoke to Robles and he swayed as he stood. Robles advised he been drinking earlier, but then he changed his story that he was not. Robles had the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. Robles did not want to complete field sobriety testing because he felt it wasn't safe. Robles did not want to provide a preliminary breath sample.

Robles had watery and glassy eyes. Robles' speech was also slurred as he spoke. Robles was taken into custody on 08/02/20 at 0112 hours for driving under the influence (private property). Squadrol Officer Prine arrived on scene and lodged Robles in the Winnebago County Justice Center.

Fabricated Evidence

1. According to the state, judge, and Sergio's previous attorney's their reason for tampering with the video evidence on (6/15/21, 6/21/22, 8/31/21, 9/20/22, and others) was due to defective audio and because it was court order to do so.

Note: On 6/17/21 a audio clip of the initial squad video was emailed to Joshua Smith by Sergio to show him that there was nothing wrong with the video evidence. In conjunction with this none of the corresponding email's between the state attorney's described any issues with the video, and no court orders or chain of custody exist to show that the modifications of the video evidence was needed or legal.

2. On 9/3/21 during a text message correspondence Sergio was informed by his attorney Joshua Smith that the reason for not having a chain of custody for the videos was because none was required or needed.

Chapter 2. Integrity, Discovery, and Disclosure of Digital Evidence



Maintaining the integrity of digital evidence throughout the process of examination presents different problems from those encountered when handling traditional physical or documentary evidence. Some common problems are exacerbated by the complexity of networked computers. This guide does not address the unique issues that may result from networked environments, focusing rather on selected issues of maintaining the integrity of information taken from stand-alone electronic media (see appendix A for a listing of sources related to network forensics).

This guide assumes that the seized media contain relevant information and that the forensic procedures used to examine that media have not altered the evidence since it was seized. After seizure, ensuring that the traditional chain of custody remains unbroken is necessary but not sufficient to establish the authenticity of the data or evidence obtained from the forensic examination. In addition to the traditional chain of custody, auxiliary precautions may be required for handling digital evidence.

This guide also assumes that tools recognized by the forensic community are used in the recovery of digital evidence from the source **electronic device** or media. Because the process used to acquire the data is itself electronic, both the evidence and the process may be subject to legal challenges. Additional expertise may be required to authenticate the machine, applications, and forensic tools. Chapter 3 discusses these issues in more depth.
