DV Relationship

ANTHONY BANKER and ASHLEY LOTT were in a romantic relationship with one child in common, REYA SMALL (1.5 yoa). ANTHONY and ASHLEY have been separated for over six months with minimal contact for parenting time.

On 040222, at approximately 1700hrs, while operating as a uniformed patrol Deputy in a fully marked patrol car, I responded to 10061 Kitsap Mall BLVD (JIMMY JOHNS). Reference multiple callers reporting a male and female arguing over a baby in the parking lot.

Upon arrival, Deputies had already separated the involved parties. I spoke with ANTHONY who appeared to be extremely upset and visibly crying. ANTHONY advised the incident as follows;

ANTHONY has been the primary parent to their daughter REYA. Today, ANTHONY had driven from Idaho to allow ASHLEY time with REYA. The two agreed to meet at the JIMMY JOHNS to get food. ANTHONY said once they had arrived, ASHLEY began trying to take REYA. ANTHONY tried stopping her from leaving but she started screaming that "he was kidnapping her child". At this point they were still inside ANTHONY's truck when people began swarming his side of the cab. One man reached in his window and took his keys from the ignition then punched him in the face. ANTHONY said he got out of the truck and tried to keep REYA from running away with his daughter. ANTHONY said as he began seeing Deputies arrive, ASHLEY turned and kicked him in the stomach. ANTHONY said it caused him pain that lingered for a few minutes.

ANTHONY explained a few months ago, he allowed ASHLEY to keep REYA so they might be able to bond. Not long after, ASHLEY had neglected to care for REYA properly causing her to become very ill. ANTHONY has had REYA full time ever since.

ANTHONY's Aunt (LAINY SMALL) and great-grandmother (KARLA HARLAN) both responded to the scene for fear that REYA might be released to ASHLEY. They both explained that ASHLEY has had episodes where she accuses ANTHONY of trying to kill her in the past. At this moment ASHLEY began yelling at ANTHONY and charging across the parking lot. Due to Deputies not being able to calm ASHLEY down, she was detained in handcuffs and placed in a patrol car. Deputy Watson #151 obtained a statement from ASHLEY. See supplements for additional details and statements.

AID responded to the scene to check on REYA, who appeared to have several small scratches on her face. AID advised the injuries appeared to be superficial and that transport wouldn't be needed. ANTHONY thinks REYA's injuries came from ASHLEY taking her from his arms inside the truck, but could not confirm. ANTHONY said REYA did not have any injuries prior to the incident today.

ASHLEY was placed under arrest for ASSAULT 4 DV and transported to KCSO Jail as a combative. See associated supplements for additional details. Patrol SGT responded to the scene. This concludes my involvement, NFI.

Supplement Notes

On April 2, 2022 at approximately 1709 hours CenCom advised of an unknown problem occurring in the parking lot of Jimmy John's 10061 Kitsap Mall Blvd. There were multiple callers advising there was some altercation between a male and female and a baby. The female was screaming "he took my baby" and yelling for "help".

Deputy Watson #151 arrived just prior to me. When I pulled into the parking lot, I could see Deputy Watson surrounded by a group of at least eight subjects, some of which were yelling and very animated. I identified ANTHONY BANKER and had him walk over to me. He was still shouting at the female half later identified as ASHLEY LOTT.

I asked ANTHONY what happened, I was told the following; he and ASHLEY used to date and have a child in common, REYA SMALL. He and REYA live in Idaho which is where REYA was born. There is no birth certificate, as the child was born outside of the hospital. There is no parenting plan in place as the families sat down and drafted their own version of a plan.

ASHLEY has some mental health issues, which has put a strain on their relationship. He came to Washington with REYA to visit ASHLEY. He was driving a pickup which belonged to ASHLEY with a camper on the back, which belonged to him. She was driving a 4-runner type vehicle which belonged to him and they ended up meeting up at the Jimmy John's parking lot area. They had planned to go to the waterfront, but when they got there it was too windy, so they came back.

While back, they got into an argument. They were all in the pickup at the time. Suddenly, ASHLEY grabbed REYA and started to run with her toward the restaurant. He gave chase to get his daughter back and in the process a crowd formed, and he and the child were struck. The child had a cut to their face. AID had been requested to evaluate the child.

While I was speaking to ANTHONY, ASHLEY kept shouting at him, and he would respond in kind. He said about a month ago ASHLEY called Washington State Patrol claiming he had kidnapped REYA, which he stated was not the case. While standing there, he called ASHLEY's father. I gathered that this behavior was not uncommon for ASHLEY based on the conversation between ANTHONY and ASHLEY's father. He said he would respond to assist.

ANTHONY's grandmother and aunt had also arrived on scene and Deputy Lechner began to speak with them. When I was finished speaking with ANTHONY, I asked him to go over to where Deputy Lechner and the rest of his family

were. I went over to speak with Deputy Miller who had been talking to other parties in the group.

While I was speaking with him, I heard ASHLEY start yelling and advancing toward ANTHONY and family. I could see Deputy Watson attempting to keep her back, but she kept pushing into him and pushing Deputy Watson back while she was actively advancing and bumping into him. I walked up to where they were and placed ASHLEY in handcuffs to prevent her from further assaulting Deputy Watson.

We escorted her around to the front of the truck out of view. She was very agitated and yelling. I asked her to sit which she refused and continued to yell. I used my foot and pushed her feet out and lowered her down onto the curb. She sat and then quickly jumped back up yelling. It was decided to place her into the back of a patrol car to de-escalate her aggressive and assaultive behavior.

After she was secured in a vehicle, I briefed the AID crew and brought them over to where REYA was. I took photos of REYA's face which were later uploaded into Digital on Q. While I was standing there, I was contacted by an employee with Five Guy's which shares the parking lot. I contacted CASEY WILSON who advised she saw ANTHONY and ASHLEY tugging on REYA and described it as, "like it [REYA] was a football". She was concerned about the child's possible injuries.

I returned to the Deputies and it was determined there was Probable Cause to arrest ASHLEY for Assault 4 - DV. ASHLEY was informed she was under arrest and Deputy Watson searched her incident to arrest. When we attempted to get her back into the patrol car, she began to scream and resist our attempts to get her in.

I got into the passenger side rear seat to assist in getting ASHLEY inside the vehicle. Deputy Watson and Deputy Denney #74 lifted her up to put her into the car. She used her feet and braced herself against the doorway screaming and would not go into the vehicle. I grabbed onto one of her feet and pulled her inside the car. I then proceeded to use my left arm in a "cross-face" across her cheek bone pinning her to seat while Deputy Watson secured her in the vehicle. I then removed the cross-face and exit the vehicle.

I requested Deputy Miller #81 follow Deputy Watson to the jail in case ASHLEY attempted to continue her aggressive behavior. ASHLEY's father arrived on scene and stated normally the family is there when they are together, to prevent such issues. He was content with REYA being with ANTHONY's and his grandmother and aunt.

Supplement Notes

On 4/2/2022 at approximately 1709 hours CENCOM dispatched an unknown problems call at 10061 Kitsap Mall BLVD NW Silverdale; Jimmy Johns. CENCOM advised there were multiple callers calling about the incident. Callers were reporting the following information: A male and female associated with a blue truck and RV camper were fighting over a baby. Female was screaming about the man taking her baby. There was also a mention of a possible gun involved. See CAD dispatch notes for exact details.

I arrived on scene approximately 1 minute from the call being dispatched. When I pulled into the parking lot I observed a large crowd of approximately 8 people huddled around a truck with a trailer. Several people were on their phones and several were yelling and shouting at one another. I approached the group and a male walked up to me and handed me a set of keys. The man stated they were the driver of the truck's keys. I continued toward the group and between a male and a female who were shouting at each other about a baby that was sitting in the passenger's seat. I observed the baby had scratch marks on its face and some slight blood. I immediately called for aid.

The female was later identified as Ashley Lott. The male was later identified as Anthony Banker. And the baby was named Reya Small.

Ashley and Anthony continued to yell at each other as I repeatedly gave them verbal commands to separate and sit on the side walk so I could figure out what was going on. Neither followed my commands and they kept shouting at each other. I asked about a gun and was informed that there was no gun and no one had seen a gun in play. A short time later SGT. Myers #27 arrived on scene and Anthony went and talked with him while I spoke with Ashley.

I began interviewing Ashley and the following is what she told me: Anthony is abusive, be littles her and has strangled her multiple times. Ashley advised she had been in a DV shelter in Idaho in December because Anthony was abusing her and threatening to take her baby. Ashley advised in Idaho Anthony said he was going to kill her if she left him and got an order.

While Ashley was telling me this information she was very amped up and was repeatedly yelling at Anthony and other people who were on scene. Several times I told Ashley to quit talking to the other people on scene and just talk to me. I also asked Ashley to talk about today's events and she began yelling at me saying I was not a Domestic Violence victim and I did not know what it was like.

Ashley then told me the following about today's incident: today she had met up with Anthony who had possession of

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their child Reyna so they could talk about things and have lunch. She advised she was in the back of the truck holding Reyna and was trying to leave the vehicle with Reyna but Anthony would not let her leave. Ashley did not specify how she could not leave. Eventually Ashley exited the vehicle and began running around with Reyna because Anthony was chasing her. Ashley said Anthony advised he was going to end this and hurt her as they were running. Eventually other people got involved and LE showed up.

I asked Ashley about the scratch on Reyna's face and she stated that it was from Reyna playing with a dog. Ashley advised she and Anthony have been dating for approximately two years but that she did not know if Anthony was the father of Reyna and he was not on the birth certificate.

It should be noted that I continuously had to ask Ashley to calm down and stop shouting at other people on scene. Ashley was very uncooperative and when I would redirect the conversation she would become agitated at me.

At one point Ashley began aggressively charging at a group of people that was speaking with Deputy Lechner. I got in her way and put my arm out to prevent Ashley from advancing however she ran into my arm and continued forward. Several times I told Ashley to quit advancing on the group of people. I grabbed Ashley's arm and began walking back to where we were originally at with her. Ashley continued to try and advance forward. SGT Myers came over and as I held onto one of her arms placed Ashley into handcuffs. Ashley was advised she was being detained as she was actively resisting lawful commands and charging at LE and civilians. SGT Myers and I attempted to have Ashley take a seat in front of a vehicle but she immediately stood back up. It was determined the back of a patrol car would be best to prevent Ashley's assaultive behavior.

In the back of my patrol car Ashley continued to scream and yell.

All LE on scene discussed statements provided and it was determined Probable Cause existed to arrest Ashley for Assault 4 DV for a kicked she had administered to Anthony. See other Deputies report's for more information.

I went back to my patrol car advised Ashley she was under arrest and asked her to step out of the vehicle. Ashley was hesitant at first but stepped out and I completed a search incident to arrest of Ashley. I located no contraband. When it was time for Ashley to sit back down in the patrol car she began actively resisting and screaming. Deputy Denney #74 and I began grabbing ahold of Ashley's arms and she was using her feet to block herself from entering the vehicle. SGT. Myer's went to the other side of the vehicle and was able to get ahold of Ashley's legs and she was placed in the back of my patrol car. As SGT Myer's restrained Ashley I secured her with lap and shoulder belts. I read Ashley her Miranda Rights verbatim from my department issued Miranda Card. Ashley stated she understood. I asked Ashley no questions as she continued to scream at me.

In Ashley's belongings were the keys to a vehicle that was registered to Anthony. Anthony need the key to the vehicle and Ashley advised she did not need anything from the vehicle and she could get it later or her father could get it.

I transported Ashley to the Kitsap County Jail where she was booked for Assault 4 D.V. with no bail.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

04-02-22 -- 1710 hours - Several KCSO units were dispatched the parking lot near Five Guys burgers for an unknown issue. I arrived and DEPUTY WATSON and SGT. MYERS were speaking to involved parties. I spoke to STEH PARK, a witness and reporting person to Cencom.

According to PARK, he was in the parking lot and heard a male and female yelling at each other near a blue truck with a camper on it. He observed a female runnign away from the male carrying a small infant. The male caught up to the female and they were pulling at each other over the infant. The male removed the infant and returned to the drivers seat of the truck, PARK told the male to stop and wait for the police, PARK reached in and was able to remove the keys from the truck ignition while he was on the phone with 911. He retained the keys and gave them to DEPUTY WATSON when he arrived. I asked PARK if there was any physical contact between he and the male in the truck, he told me no. I asked if he pushed or struck the male in the truck, he told me no. He was able to reach in and remove the keys, the male did not even attempt to slap his hand out of the way. PARK advised he got involved over the concern for the child the 2 were arguing over and wanted to make sure the infant is not hurt.
