Hello,

This email is intended for Mark Jackson regarding a police corruption case he prosecuted successfully in 2016.

In 2014/2015 I was arrested on several cases in placer, yolo, el dorado county drug and weapons charges. In 2 of the arrests a SLEDNET officer named Mark Zlendick was either involved with a search warrant or working with me as my handler in exchange for information.

A 3rd case in Yolo county landed me there unable to bail, and after several years of litigation a trial commenced, in which at this time the detective was on bail for corruption and other drug related offenses. Prosecutors did not disclose this extremely exculpatory information before my trial or anytime since. The detective was arrested in May of 2015 and tried in February 2016. I was arrested in October 2014 and tried in January 2016 and sentenced to a total of 14 years 8 months.

I know for a fact this deputy stole money from me that was seized as evidence because the amount seized and the amount i had was exactly \$1000 less, i mentioned to my attorney although, she sucked and did nothing for me at trial. There are other issues around my case that are questionable such as the DA being allowed to instruct the jury that the totality of circumstances from these other cases where Zlendick was involved could be considered to convict me without having to show any specific intent or previous evidence of sales.

So I am writing to you to ask if you are able or willing to contact my trial court DA or judicial trial clerk to have my sentence recalled and set aside in the interest of justice. This is likely the most straightforward way for a person to have theirs recalled in California short of having to hire and pay an attorney, which is sad to say since a person shouldnt be deprived of the help in which they are in need. Honestly I can't just call my personal printing press to have it done.

Mr. Lucas,

I prosecuted Mr. Zlendick for crimes he committed in Douglas County, Nevada. I do not have the power, authority or jurisdiction to become involved in any other criminal matter in any other city, county or state. I know nothing about your case. If you believe Mr. Zlendick stole money from you, then file a report with the law enforcement agency in the city or county where the crime occurred. I will not contact any party in your California case. The fact that Mr. Zlendick committed crimes while employed as a peace officer does not mean that other people who committed crimes during the time he was a peace officer should be allowed to go free. If you committed crimes, then you should serve your sentence. If you are factually innocent, then you may pursue appropriate remedies through the appropriate California courts.
