Court documents reveal how the gunman in the attack on the Chabad of Poway obtained the weapon used in the shooting. NBC 7's Danny Freeman has the details.

A San Diego man accused of opening fire at a Poway synagogue apparently purchased his weapon at a local gun store. That information comes from search warrants unsealed Wednesday morning in connection with the investigation.

The warrants reveal investigators found a "gun receipt and paperwork" that indicate shooter John Earnest purchased the rifle at "San Diego Guns." A business by that name is located on Mission Gorge Road.

On Wednesday, the owner of San Diego Guns, **Dallas** Martensen, declined to comment on the new details.

The warrants also reveal officers found the Smith and Wesson M&P-15 rifle in the suspect's car, along with five loaded magazines and a black helmet with a GoPro camera attached.

Law enforcement gathered evidence in the hours and days after **Earnest** attacked the Chabad of Poway on April 27, 2019. The shooting killed one worshipper and injured three other people, including the synagogue's rabbi.

Marines investigate reservist's alleged ties to supremacist group

SAN DIEGO — A San Diego-based Marine Corps reservist is under investigation by the Marines after membership interviews with a white supremacist hate group were leaked by activists and highlighted in a subsequent Southern Poverty Law Center report.

In its report, the SPLC found that 1 in 5 applicants to Patriot Front claimed to be either on active duty or veterans of the military. It highlighted one applicant who said he was a San Diegobased Marine veteran.

San Diego activists affiliated with “The Activated Podcast” were the first to point to Krvaric as possibly being the person named in the leaked chats as “Interviewee 441515.”

A Marine Corps Reserve spokesperson confirmed Wednesday that the service is investigating whether Krvaric is the interviewee.

Military members are prohibited from participating in extremist

insurrection at the U.S. Capitol.

Krvaric did not respond Tuesday to a text message sent to a number associated with him. When a San Diego Union-Tribune reporter called Wednesday, a young man answered, refused to identify himself and hung up.

Krvaric joined the Marines in July 2018 and is assigned to the 4th Light Armored Reconnaissance Battalion at Camp Pendleton, the Marines said.

According to the SPLC, Patriot Front

In January, activists from the reporting collective Unicorn Riot published more than 400 gigabytes of leaked Patriot Front communications.

In a membership interview report, “Interviewee 441515” told Patriot Front that he believed in antisemitic conspiracy theories and that non-Europeans shouldn’t be allowed in the U.S. unless they were “doctors” or a “net positive” to the economy.

The applicant told the group he was working as a guard with the Department of Homeland Security, handling inmate check-ins. According to his LinkedIn account, Krvaric works for contractor Stratus Security Management, handling detainees for the Department of Homeland Security.

The applicant also told the group he needed for his father’s financial

Carlsbad Teacher's Shooting Death Was Self-Defense: Suspect's Father

Julie Harper is accused of killing her husband, Jason, days after asking for divorce

The woman on trial for her husband's murder said she shot him out of self-defense, her father testified Thursday.

John Cihak reluctantly took the stand in the trial of his daughter [Julie Harper](#), 41, accused of first-degree murder in the death of her husband, beloved Carlsbad High School teacher Jason Harper. He was shot to death inside the couple's Carlsbad home on Aug. 7, 2012, just days after his wife asked him for a divorce.

Prosecutors made it clear in court that Cihak was not willing to testify against his daughter, but the District Attorney's Office sent him a subpoena to require it.

Cihak told the jury his daughter unexpectedly showed up alone at his Normal Heights real estate office on Aug. 7, 2012.

Garmo has also pleaded guilty to federal charges of selling guns without a license and was sentenced in 2021 to two years in federal prison.

Hamel avoided time behind bars by cooperating with the government's investigation, according to prosecutors.

Gun company under investigation in California given taxpayer funded incentives to relocate to Tennessee

Tennessee officials say they were unaware of the investigation when they signed a contract

A firearms manufacturer lured to do business in Nashville with a \$165,000 state job creation grant is currently under investigation by the California Attorney General over allegations it engaged in illegal or deceptive advertising in its sales of gun kits, which allow consumers to assemble their own firearms from parts and bypass gun purchase laws.

The criminal investigation was apparently unknown to Tennessee officials when they agreed to steer taxpayer-funded incentives to GS Performance, also known as [Glockstore](#), a spokeswoman for the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development (ECD) said Friday.

"ECD conducts thorough due diligence for each project before it is considered for incentives," an email from Molly Hair, the spokeswoman, said. "At the time GS Performance submitted its application and the due diligence was performed, the department was unaware of any investigations."

The contract between the company and the state of Tennessee was signed in May. The California investigation has been ongoing since October 2019.

Hair did not respond to a Friday late-afternoon follow up question asking when the company first submitted the application.

In August of this year, California Attorney General Xavier Becerra went to court to force the company to comply with subpoenas and document requests he said the company had failed to respond to for nearly a year. The petition filed in San Francisco Superior Court remains in litigation, a spokesperson for the Attorney General confirmed Thursday.

"We believe Glockstore may be endangering our communities and violating California law," Becerra said in an August [news release](#) announcing his petition in the San Francisco court that was reported on by California news organizations.

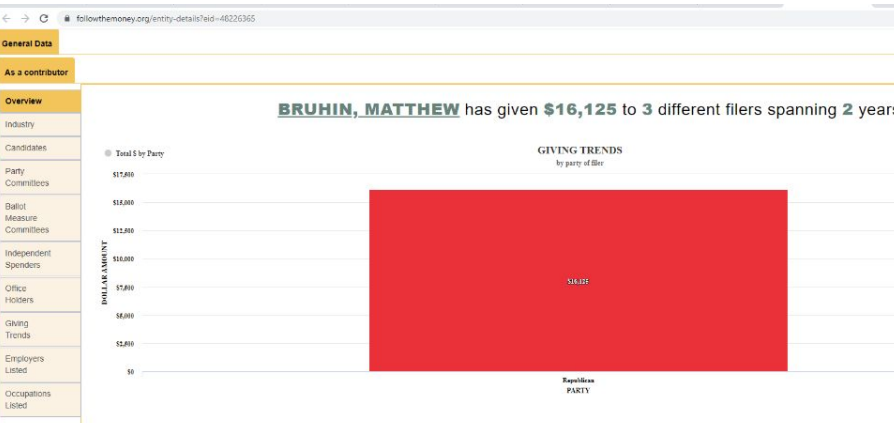

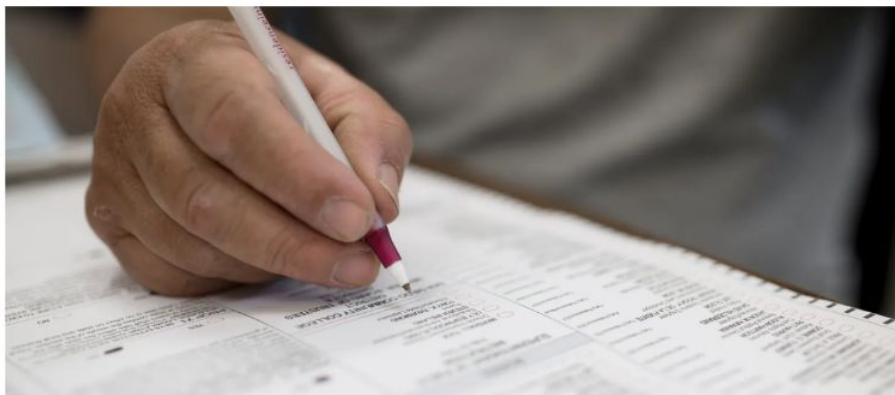

Of all the LLC money in San Diego city campaigns, 79 percent has supported the SoccerCity ballot measure. The measure would turn the city's former Qualcomm Stadium site into a retail center, river park and soccer stadium. One group, Bridgewest Ventures LLC, has given more than \$593,000.

Here's another example: LHR Investment Company LLC gave \$3.8 million to San Diegans for Housing Opportunities Yes On B in 2016. The group supported Measure B, which would have changed county zoning rules to allow Lilac Hills Ranch, a 608-acre housing development north of Escondido. (It failed.)

State law does not require LLCs to file campaign reports listing donors and sources of income, like PACs are required to do, so we can't see where the investment company's money is coming from. LHR Investment Co. does file another kind of campaign report called a Form 461, which is required by donors who spend at least \$10,000 in an election, but those forms don't break down where the LLC's money is coming from.

And because the LLC's parent company is registered in Delaware, we can't get the full details of who operates the organization.

That doesn't sound good. What's 'gray money,' then?

Gray money is money in our elections where the source of the funding is partly obscured or difficult to obtain.
