Initial Report

On January 1st, 2017 at approximately 13:47 hours dispatch advised of an assault complainant on station that wished to speak to an officer. Upon my arrival I met with Lauren McClain, and her four year old daughter Maddie. Ms. McClain advised that her and her live in boyfriend Kory Hamilton had a verbal argument that turned physical. Ms. McClain was noticeably upset, and crying.

Ms. McClain advised that she was upstairs and she could hear Kory yelling at his mother on the phone. She advised that her daughter was downstairs with Kory and she could tell that she was getting scared. She further explained that she went down to get her daughter and asked Kory to please not yell like that in front of her daughter as it scares her. Ms. McClain then claimed that Kory "lost it" and began to yell and scream at her. She retreated upstairs with her daughter to get away from him, but he followed. Ms. McClain further explained that the yelling continued so she took her daughter into the bathroom with her, but Mr. Hamilton attempted to get into the bathroom, eventually breaking the door, and frame.

Ms. McClain explained that she was hit by the door several times as he was trying to get inside. Ms. McClain advised that she then shoved the door back on Mr. Hamilton and shoved him out of the bathroom, in to the bed room, and on to the bed. She advised that he never struck her, nor did he threaten to cause any physical harm to her. Mr. McClain stated that she did fight back, but only to get out of the bathroom.

Ms. McClain then took her daughter and came to the Willard Police Department to file a complaint. I observed Ms. McClain for any injuries and found none. She stated that he never really hit her, only with the bathroom door. She stated that it was more pushing and shoving, but it was mutual. Officer Ritz made his way to the listed address to speak with the male half. Mr. Hamilton advised the same exact story and advised that it was pushing and shoving, but he never laid a hand on her, nor did she on him. He refused to provide a written statement, and just wanted her to leave. Ms. McClain had her daughters father, and his girlfriend meet her on station to pick up the child. They volunteered to take Lauren and her daughter in for a couple of days.

Ms. McClain asked for a civil standby while she retrieved some items from her apartment. I assisted her in retrieving some items and there was no issues. Mr. Hamilton and his mother and father also stood by in the apartment to prevent any issues. Ms. McClain was instructed to call the police department when she was coming to retrieve the rest of her items in the home. She stated that she would do that, and was concerned that her items may be damaged. She requested to take pictures of her things but then changed her mind. Ms. McClain's gathered some belongings, and left for the remainder of the evening. Nothing further was needed.
