On 10-22-18, Officer Baez, responded to 1610 Brack Street, Kissimmee, Florida, in reference to a joint response with DCF regarding a lewd/lascivious molestation of a child.

Officer Baez met with DCF Child Protective Investigator Carey Cooper, who provided him with the initial intake report summarized as follows: CPI Cooper's report indicated that Jazzmen Kingston was threatening to harm herself and her daughter [REDACTED] (DOB 2-17-06). The report indicated that this was due to a recent break up with boyfriend, Joseph Puryear. The report also stated there are concerns that Joseph has sexually touched [REDACTED] on several occasions.

Officer Baez met with Jazzmen who provided a sworn written statement summarized as follows: Jazzmen stated that in the summer of 2017, while living in Villa Del Sol Apartments in Kissimmee (2208 Antigua Place Apt 922), Joseph was helping [REDACTED] with homework. Jazzmen said as she was walking towards the door, she observed Joseph rub his hand on [REDACTED] buttocks. Jazzmen said she confronted [REDACTED] and Joseph about the situation and both denied anything was happening. Jazzmen said she separated [REDACTED] from Joseph, and she asked her what was going on. Jazzmen said [REDACTED] confessed to her that Joseph had touched her private parts over the clothing. Jazzmen said [REDACTED] told her this occurred twice over the summer of 2017. Jazzmen explained she later asked Joseph again about the situation, and he again denied it. Jazzmen said two days later, Joseph admitted to her that he touched [REDACTED]. Jazzmen said Joseph told her that he was intoxicated and made a huge mistake. Jazzmen said she stopped talking to Joseph, but was afraid to speak up because no one believed her when she went through the same situation as a child. Jazzmen said she made sure [REDACTED] and Joseph had no contact, and she would constantly ask [REDACTED] if Joseph touched her again. Jazzmen said [REDACTED] always answered by saying "No." Jazzmen said since she moved to her current address (1610 Brack Street) in December of 2017, there were no more incidents between Joseph and [REDACTED]. Jazzmen said she broke up with Joseph two weeks ago and he has been out of the house since that time. Jazzmen wishes to prosecute and testify in court on behalf of [REDACTED].

Jazzmen was unable to provide Officer Baez with any information regarding Joseph's whereabouts other than that he possibly went back to New York. Jazzmen provided Officer Baez with Joseph's personal information since they were in a romantic relationship and lived together for several years. CPI Cooper put a safety plan into place for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] is to reside with her Aunt, Lizmarie German, until further notice. CPI Cooper advised that Jazzmen shall not have any unsupervised visits with [REDACTED].

On 10-24-18, I, Detective Santone, received and reviewed this case. I made contact with CPT Cooper who assisted with setting up a Forensic Interview appointment with Jade on 10-29-18. The Forensic Interview was conducted by Case Coordinator Alison Cowell at 110 W Neptune Road, Kissimmee, FL. Detective Antepara was also present during the CPT interview with [REDACTED]. During the forensic interview with [REDACTED], she disclosed that she was touched by Joseph on several occasions. [REDACTED] stated that when she was about 11 years old (approximately one year ago), she was living at Villa Del Sol. Joseph was supposed to help her with social studies homework. [REDACTED] went to sit on the couch by Joseph but he put his hand on the couch before she sat down. When she sat down, she sat on Joseph's hand, and he began squeezing her buttocks. [REDACTED] tried to push Joseph's hand away but Joseph pushed back and continued to squeeze [REDACTED]'s buttocks. Jazzmen exited her bedroom and saw Joseph touching [REDACTED] and Joseph said, "It's not what it looks it." Jazzmen then questioned [REDACTED] about what happened, and [REDACTED] told her that Joseph was rubbing her "from front to back," from her vagina to her buttocks. Jazzmen stated she heard Joseph and Jazzmen arguing in the bedroom after the homework incident. According to [REDACTED], she heard Jazzmen and Joseph arguing about the incident and they did not speak to each other for a few days. [REDACTED] advised it took Joseph about 2 days to finally confess to Jazzmen about touching [REDACTED] buttocks. [REDACTED] stated after he confessed to Jazzmen, Joseph apologized to [REDACTED] for touching her and said he was not supposed to do that. [REDACTED] disclosed that even after Jazzmen saw what happened and Joseph confessed to her, Jazzmen would continue to leave Joseph alone with her and her 7 year old brother, [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] also stated there was another time (after the homework incident) when Joseph came into her room when she was sleeping and went onto her bed and started rubbing her buttocks. [REDACTED] said she saw Joseph at the foot of her bed, leaning over her as she laid in bed when he was rubbing her butt (over the clothing) with his hands. Joseph stopped when he heard her mom's bedroom door open, which [REDACTED] says started him. [REDACTED] stated that Joseph would come into her room when she was in bed and would rub her areas. [REDACTED] identified her "areas" as her top "area" to include her breasts and her "lower area" to include her vagina and buttocks. [REDACTED] initially stated Joseph would do this to her only a few times but then later disclosed this occurred almost nightly. [REDACTED] stated that he was using his hands to touch her "lower and top areas" and stated it was over her clothing.

[REDACTED] disclosed that she told her mom about a second time it happened when Joseph was touching her buttocks and vagina area, but Jazzmen continued to leave [REDACTED] in the unsupervised care of Joseph. Jazzmen was in hospital for several days around "Easter time" of 2018 and left [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in the care of Joseph for that entire time. [REDACTED] stated that she just turned 12 years old and that she does have her menstrual cycle. [REDACTED] indicated that in July of 2018, she missed her menstrual cycle and Jazzmen was worried about why she missed her period. Jazzmen believe that [REDACTED] may have missed her period due to Joseph's actions and kept asking [REDACTED] if anything happened with her and Joseph. [REDACTED] said she did not tell anyone else what was going on with Joseph, other than her mom, because she was afraid and did not fully understand what was happening.

Jazzmen brought [REDACTED] to the Forensic Interview and in a noncustodial atmosphere; Detective Antepara briefly spoke with Jazzmen. Jazzmen advised that she only knew of two times that Joseph inappropriately touched [REDACTED]. Jazzmen advised that she walked in on Joseph touching [REDACTED] in her vagina and buttocks area. Jazzmen also advised that Joseph confessed to her, apologized, and advised that he wasn't in the "right state of mind."

On 10-30-18, I, Detective Santone, made contact with Jazzmen. Jazzmen agreed to come into the Kissimmee Police Department to speak with me about the incident. Since Detective Antepara made contact with Jazzmen and [REDACTED] at CPT on 10-29-18, he assisted me with interviewing Jazzmen. I began the background information form and before I could continue or ask any questions, Jazzmen broke down and began crying. Jazzmen stated that she "messed up" and "made a mistake." Jazzmen stated that she was trying to "fix" Joseph and tried to forgive him. Jazzmen stated that when Joseph was helping [REDACTED] with her homework, she walked in and saw Joseph behind [REDACTED]. She said she saw Joseph removing his hand from [REDACTED] crotch area. She stated she got

into an argument with him and that it took him about two days to apologize. Joseph came into Jazzmen's job and apologized to her about touching [REDACTED] and told her that he was not in the right state of mind. Jazzmen said she would continuously ask [REDACTED] if Joseph kept touching her and stated that when [REDACTED] missed her period in July of 2018, she immediately thought it was because of Joseph. Jazzmen stated that she video called Joseph on 10-22-18 and told him that DCF was there taking her "baby." Jazzmen stated she knew that it was going to come out that she "knew he was touching her." Jazzmen stated that she asked [REDACTED] if it has happened before and [REDACTED] said yes in her room. [REDACTED] proceeded to tell Jazzmen about the time Joseph came into her room at night and would touch her on top of her clothes. Jazzmen stated that she has been holding this in and living a lie and that she wanted to "save him." Jazzmen stated that she was hospitalized for about a week or so and left her kids in the care of Joseph.

Jazzmen stated that she hasn't spoken to Joseph since he moved out of the house and they broke up on 10-06-18. Jazzmen indicated that Joseph may have fled back up to New York because he doesn't have any friends or family in the area. Jazzmen provided me with Joseph's phone number but stated he may have changed it and stated that they've only been speaking through Facebook Messenger. Jazzmen allowed me to look at the Facebook messages between her and Joseph. I observed many messages between Joseph and her about how Joseph left her for another woman and Jazzmen kept telling him that he left their family for this other woman. I did not observe any messages from Jazzmen telling Joseph that they were ending their relationship because he inappropriately touched [REDACTED]. I also observed many messages begging for him back and also making threats of taking her own life if he was not with her.

Based on Jazzmen's knowledge and observations of the incident and based on [REDACTED] statements and forensic interview, I find probable cause to believe that Jazzmen Kingston violated FSS 827.03(2)(d)-Child Neglect (two counts), when Jazzmen knowingly and willingly knew about two instances where [REDACTED] was sexually molested by Joseph (and observing one for herself) and failed to protect [REDACTED] from further molestation. Jazzmen also violated FSS 777.04/827.03(2)(b)-Conspiracy to commit Child abuse, when she knowingly and willingly continued to facilitate unsupervised contact between Joseph and [REDACTED] after he sexually molested [REDACTED] in Jazzmen's presence which inflicted emotional and mental injury upon [REDACTED].

An arrest warrant is requested to be issued for **Jazzmen Kingston**; charging her with two counts of **Child Neglect**, pursuant to Florida State Statute **827.03(2)(D)**, and one count of **Conspiracy to Commit Child Abuse**, pursuant to Florida State Statute **777.04/827.03(2)(B)**. 02/19/2019 Basis for no information:

1. A no information notice was filed in 2018-CF-3923. That case constituted the "child abuse" for this charge. This ASA concluded that there was insufficient evidence to prove the allegations against Puryear beyond a reasonable doubt. That decision was reached, in part, because this ASA concluded that there may not have been a lewd or lascivious intent during the "homework incident."

2. The fact that the State decided not to charge Puryear would likely be used to undermine the prosecution of Kingston.

3. Kingston's statements to law enforcement must be evaluated in the context of [REDACTED] Puryear. It is not unreasonable to believe that Kingston dramatized these incidents because she sought retribution against Puryear.

D stated that she separated V from [REDACTED] and V confessed that [REDACTED] had touched her private area over her clothing twice during the summer of 2017. D stated she asked [REDACTED] about the situation again and he denied it but 2 days later he told D that he was drunk and made a mistake.

D stated she did not tell anyone because the same thing happened to her when she was young and no one believed her.

D stated they moved to their current home in Dec of 2017 and there were no other incidents between V and [REDACTED]. D stated she made sure that V was never alone with him and D stated she questioned V regularly.

D advised that she and [REDACTED] D stated she doesn't know where he is but thinks he may be in New York.

DCF placed V with her aunt and is not to have unsupervised contact with D.

Forensic interview was done with V who advised that [REDACTED] touched her on several occasion. That he was to help her with her homework and as she went to sit on the couch, he put his hand out so that she sat on it and he squeezed. V stated that she told D about these incidents but D continued to leave V alone with [REDACTED]. There was also a time when D was in the hospital for appx 1 week and V and her brother were left in the care of [REDACTED].

D spoke with LEO at KPD regarding the situation, D broke down in tears and stated she "messed up" and "made a mistake", that she was trying to "fix" him. D stated she saw [REDACTED] removing his hand from V's crotch and she stated that [REDACTED] apologized a few days later saying he wasn't in the right state of mind.

D stated she's only spoke with [REDACTED] through Facebook Messenger, and she allowed LEO to look at the messages. LEO notes that the messages were about [REDACTED] and there was nothing about the V. LEO also noted that there were many messages from D [REDACTED]
