Your correspondence was received by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), Orlando Regional Operations Center. In your correspondence you made multiple allegations regarding a lack of "accountability for illegal, unethical, and immoral actions" occurring at the Kissimmee Police Department. Upon review, it was determined that your complaint does not warrant an investigation by FDLE, as the allegations do not support that any criminal violations of Florida law have occurred.

Florida law states that the employing agency is responsible for investigating complaints against officers within their agency. Therefore, any complaints regarding alleged misconduct by members of the Kissimmee Police Department should be directed to the Kissimmee Police Department Internal Affairs / Professional Standards Unit and the City Attorney for their review and any action deemed appropriate. In an effort to further assist you, the Orlando Regional Operations Center is forwarding your complaint to the Kissimmee Police Department and the City Attorney for review.
