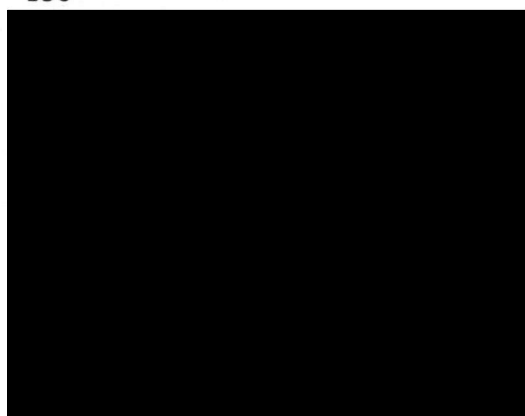

Original Narrative - 05/06/2025 19:10:01

On 5/06/2025 at approximately 1650 hours I, Inv. Scarborough was driving north in the 6600 block of U.S. 221, Spartanburg County (near intersection of Center Point Dr). The speed limit on this road in this area is 55mph.

While driving northbound in lane 1 a Silver Porsche SUV with SC tag 352AOL came up behind me at a high rate of speed. It then maneuvered around me and passed me in lane 2 and continued to drive north at a high rate of speed. I then caught up to and paced the vehicle, and found it to be going 85mph in a 55mph zone. I then activated my blue lights and sirens and attempted to initiate a traffic stop for reckless driving. The suspect, identified once in custody as Devin Bailey, slowed down to 50-60mph but did not stop. I notified dispatch that I was in pursuit and started giving regular updates over the radio. During the entirety of the chase traffic conditions were light, the roads were dry, and the weather was clear and sunny.

We drove north on US 221 and the suspect came to a stop at a red traffic light near the intersection of US 221 and I-26. The suspect then yelled out the window to me that "you can't stop me" and then continued to drive north on US 221 when the light turned green. I noted that the suspect was a black male and appeared to be the only occupant in the vehicle. I had dispatch run the tag on the vehicle to determine the owner. The dispatcher provided the registered owner's name and I noted it was a female. The suspect continued to drive north on US 221 at a speed of 52mph in a 45mph zone. Other chase conditions were as previously listed.

We passed N Timms Creek Ave and the suspect was going approximately 60mph in a 45mph zone. Other chase conditions were as previously listed. The suspect then took a right on Happy Ln, then another right on Stone Station Rd. He then pulled into the parking lot of Foster Chapel Baptist Church at 2800 Stone Station Rd. I noted the suspect then rolled his driver window up.

Myself and other deputies performed a felony traffic stop on the vehicle. The suspect initially refused to get out of the vehicle but after several minutes of verbal commands and a K9 barking he complied and was taken into custody without incident.

A sweep of the vehicle confirmed that Devin was the only occupant. He was identified through his South Carolina driver's license. I mirandized Devin and tried to speak to him about the incident but he just kept repeating "I do not consent to any searches." An inventory of his vehicle prior to tow was conducted and it was found he had a Glock ____ handgun, regular magazine with ____ rounds, and a drum magazine with ____ rounds in it. He also had a ski-type mask in the vehicle.

Devin's license was not suspended and he had no previous criminal history. He was placed under arrest for reckless driving and failure to stop for blue lights, first offense. He was transported to the jail by a patrol deputy. I drove to the jail and issued Devin the following citations:

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT:

On 05/06/25, I responded to the area of Highway 221 and Happy Lane within the jurisdiction of Spartanburg County in reference to assisting Investigator Scarborough who was had a vehicle not stopping for him.

Due to him advising that the vehicle had just taken Happy lane, I knew that the direction he was heading was gonna put him out on Stone Station Road. Due to this

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT:

On 05/06/2025 I, Deputy Starnes was responding to Investigator Scarborough that was in pursuit of a vehicle on US221 within Spartanburg County. By the time I was able to catch up with Investigator Scarborough, he was coming from Happy Ln. taking a right onto Stone Station Rd. Deputy Hammett was in front of me and called that he was 2nd in the pursuit and after that I called out that I was 3rd in the pursuit. The vehicle then came to a slow stop in the parking lot of FOSTER CHAPEL BAPTIST, at 2800 STONE STATION RD. At that point, I pulled out my departmental issued firearm from my holster and did a felony stop on the vehicle. At that point Kilo 5 arrived on scene and took over verbal commands. After a period of Mr. Bailey ignoring all verbal commands, once the K9 started barking, Mr. Bailey then exited the vehicle and followed all verbal commands. Mr. Bailey was taken into custody without incident. I then placed Mr. Bailey in the back of my patrol vehicle, secured him with a seatbelt per departmental policy, and safely transported him to the Spartanburg County Detention Center without further incident.

This concludes my involvement with this incident.

On 05/06/2025 I, Dep K Hendrich, responded to the area of Stone Station Rd & Carolina Country Club Rd within Spartanburg County in reference to a vehicle pursuit. The pursuit came to an end near this intersection when the suspect driver voluntarily pulled over into a church parking lot.

Upon arrival, I observed multiple deputies conducting a high risk vehicle stop on the suspect vehicle. Due to the suspect already attempted to flee law enforcement and barricading himself in his vehicle, I deployed PSD Kion attaching a 50ft leash to his flat collar. I then positioned myself at the front driver side of the front police vehicle. I began giving commands to the driver to exit the vehicle and warned him that failure to do so would result in him getting bit by a police canine. The suspect refused to comply for several minutes but eventually opened the door and began to step out. Just as the driver began to exit the vehicle, a deputy to my right began yelling commands causing PSD Kion to now focus on the deputy. I got PSD Kion to focus back towards the suspect as he exited the vehicle. The suspect was then successfully taken into custody without further incident. I returned PSD Kion to my patrol vehicle.

I then assisted with a search of the suspect vehicle. I located two pairs of gardening style gloves and facemask in the driver door pocket. A 10mm Glock pistol with extended magazine was located by other deputies in the front passenger seat.

PSD Kion is a dual purpose working dog currently certified through High Drive K9 Inc.

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
